We are delighted to introduce our wine list, which has been arranged in a descriptive style, rather than the traditional way of region by region. Hopefully this will make wine selection easier, and by informing customers how less familiar wines taste, it should also encourage people to try new wines rather than just going for the well known 'brand' regions like Rioja or Sancerre (not that there's anything wrong with that - we have seriously good examples from both regions!).

There is obviously an element of subjectivity in this style of list, as 'medium bodied red' might not mean the same to everyone, and there are arguably some wines which could be on either side of the fence, but largely we feel it is fairly accurate and with that in mind hope that you will enjoy perusing the list and be rewarded with a splendid selection.

Some of our wines would benefit from being decanted, if you would like your wine decanting please bring it to the attention of the staff.

All the wines in this list are supplied by Bowland Forest Vintners, our wine merchants who have their wine shop in the front of the hotel. Now in their 32nd year of trading they have a wonderful selection of fine and interesting wines from around the world. All wines chosen are from real winemakers who concentrate on real quality, rather than mass produced 'factory farm' wines. Bowland Forest Vintners offer first rate advice, and back it up with very friendly and efficient service.

N.B.

We would like to advise that vintages could be liable to change within this list. Whilst we try our best, sometimes we get caught out and therefore we would like to advise that vintages within this list are normally correct and only sometimes wrong!

| | This is the second wine of Ch. Lagrange and with such pedigree quality can hardly come as a surprise. It has all the attributes of its' big brother and offers a beautifully mature glass of claret with garnet hue, cassis fruit and hints of old saddlery. | |

- 043 1990 Chateau d'Armailhac, 5eme Cru Pauillac 115.00**
Another Chateau from the Rothschild stable producing superb quality claret. 1990 was a very fine vintage and this wine offers classic aged characteristics with hints of cedar and leather yet still with plenty of fruit. Enjoy with any red meat or game.
- 183 Ch. Sociando Mallet 1989, Haut Medoc 100.00**
Age cannot wither her.....still most youthful and offering superb dark fruit, hints of cedar together with aromas of leather. It's fantastic to find Haut Medoc which remain as vibrant after 30 years. Drinking well above its' ordinary classification.
- 123 1989 Chateau Gruaud Larose, 2eme Cru Saint Julien 145.00**
A name which is synonymous with highest quality Bordeaux and whenever we find some this Chateau is first on the team sheet! It has now dis-robbed itself of any lingering tannins and is showing delicate fruit and savoury aspects with hints of leather and smoke. We can't think of many better ways to enjoy some game than with a big glass of this beauty.
- 091 1986 Chateau d'Angludet, Margaux 88.00**
One of the oldest Chateaux, dating back to 1150. Shown blind in December 2017, nobody even got close to guessing the vintage such is the youthfulness of this terrific wine! Still with very decent fruit and lovely length, it is great value.
- 083 1982 Chateau Branaire Ducru, 4eme Cru Saint Julien 135.00**
Saint Julien is the smallest of the Medoc Communes, but it produces more than its' fair share of the world's finest wines! Here is yet another example from arguably the vintage of the century, no less!!
A fantastic nose of blueberries, blackberries, cassis, cedar and dark chocolate together with a silky palate of sweet, ripe fruit. Very memorable.
- 040 1970 Chateau Haut Bailly, Grand Cru Classe Graves 150.00**
This gorgeous 48 year old is showing beautifully with no signs of age at all, save the brick red colour in the glass. Gentle, elegant and smooth, there is still plenty of fruit and the finish is long. This is a special treat for anyone who loves mature Bordeaux as much as we do!

Australia

965 Wynn's 'Michael' Shiraz 1993, Coonawarra, S. Australia 90.00

So often the 'go to' name when it comes to Australia, Wynn's have such consistency you are never disappointed. Michael is only produced in exceptional vintages. Matured in American oak for 18 months, it is rich and complex with mulberry fruit characteristics, with a touch of mocha.

653 Henschke 'Cyril' Cabernet Sauvignon 2000, Eden Valley, S. Australia 90.00

Sneaking onto the Vintners Selection out of pure favouritism this is top quality wine from one of the best makers in Australia. With a dash of Cabernet Franc and Merlot it offers delicious flavours of ripe blackcurrant and mulberry, together with a touch of cedar and cigar. Rich and complex, the old man after who this cuvee is named would be very proud.

665 Jim Barry 'The Armagh' Shiraz 1996 - Clare Valley, South Australia 160.00

The Armagh is one of Australia's iconic wines, very little being made and extremely sort after. We are delighted to be able to list it and we know Aussie aficionados are going to well up when they see it listed! Beautifully balanced, powerful Clare Shiraz with pepper, menthol and spice characteristics underpinned by dark berry fruit, it is still remarkably youthful and is wonderful with any red meat.

062 Chateau Doisy Vedrines 1990, Premier Cru Classe, Sauternes (37.5cl) 60.00

Sensational effort from one of the best in the business. Unctuous is a word invented for this little beauty, with lip-smacking flavours of apricot, coconut, and hints of flower blossom. You have to treat yourself occasionally.....

Created in homage to Sir Winston Churchill, Pol Roger only produce this very special cuvee in the very best vintages. The exact blend is a specially guarded secret but includes both Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Grand Cru sites. Full bodied, rich and long, it is very expressive with flavours of peach and almonds.
- 155 Moet et Chandon Dom Perignon Vintage 2006 185.00**
Rich, intense and creamy, this is a spectacular Champagne. Layer on layer of almonds and hazelnuts, along with lovely tangy citrus flavours of grapefruit. 50% Chardonnay, 34% Pinot Noir, 16% Pinot Meunier. Blissful.

- 218 Tallero Prosecco Spumante DOC Treviso Extra Dry, Veneto 28.00**
Delightfully fresh sparkling wine from the Northern Italian region of Veneto. Crisp and fresh with lovely citrus characters.
- 106 Charles Pelletier Grand Reserve Blanc de Blancs, Méthode Traditional, France 29.00**
Heralding from the Burgundy region, and made by the Champagne method, this excellent sparkling wine is ideal as an aperitif. It is fun, fresh and elegant.
- 211 Charles Pelletier Grand Reserve Rose, Méthode Traditional, France 29.00**
Made using Shiraz. Fresh and with enough weight and fruit to be enjoyed with or without food.
- 803 Cremant de Limoux, Antech 'Cuvee Eugenie' 2016, Languedoc 35.00**
A lovely dry wine with tiny bubbles and a beautiful creamy character. The perfect aperitif, it will also go very well with white meats, shellfish and seafood.
- 195 Court Garden Classic Cuvee Brut 2014, East Suss, Méthode Traditional 57.50**
Made very much in the style of the sparkling wine from N. France, it has a pretty nose of greengage and apples, with a touch of toast. A beautiful, long finish and a tiny mousse, it is a joy to drink.

- 770 Sauvignon Blanc 2017, Villaricca, Maule Valley (Chile) 19.50**
Wonderfully crisp with a zingy palate of tropical fruits. Grassy and fresh, this wine offers more than many may expect from Chilean Sauvignon. Really enjoyable.
- 326 Pinot Grigio 2017, Viamora - Veneto (Italy) 19.50**
We sell buckets of this lovely modern Pinot Grigio from Sicily. Fresh and crisp, it has gorgeous aromas of pears and apples and a full flavour and pronounced fruit.
- 775 Tres Reyes Blanco 2017 - Toledo (Spain) 23.50**
Shipped directly from high altitude Toledo in central Spain, this top value Blanco is a delicious blend of Macabeo and Verdejo. The cool nights allow slow ripening and the gorgeously intense acidity, which keeps it lively and suitable for drinking with or without food.
- 338 Muscadet 'Sur Lie' Sevre et Maine 2017, Domaine Bigotiere (Loire) 23.50**
Finally Muscadet is making a come back! World renowned as the true match for 'Fruits de Mers' – Seafood to you and me. It disappeared off wine radars with the New World invasion. Beautifully dry with a touch of complexity from the lees treatment.
- 305 Sauvignon de Touraine 2017, Domaine de Rablais (Loire) 24.50**
Downstream from the famous Villages of Sancerre and Pouilly comes this wonderfully expressive, zesty Sauvignon with gorgeous crisp flavours on both nose and palate which make your mouth water just to think about them! As a drink on its' own or with food, it is a delight.
- 994 Albarino Calazul 2017, Rias Baixas (Spain) 27.50**
Albarino is the indigenous grape of Rias Baixas in Galicia, North-West Spain. Regarded as Spain's alternative to Viognier in terms of its fresh peachy aromatics. Very popular in Madrid's chic bars and restaurants.
- 518 Verdicchio di Gino 2016 San Lorenzo, Marche (Italy) 29.00**
From Marche in Italy's east. It is a complex wine, punching well above its' price point. Fabulous aromas of white flower blossom, apples and pears together with a distinct nutty character. Lovely long flavours and truly great value, it's one for all occasions.

- 256 Chablis 2017, Domaine Hamelin, Burgundy 39.50**
This is a superb, traditional style Chablis with the typical flinty, mineral characteristics. Quite light in style, this does not pretend to be a big, buttery Côte d'Or wine. The company is a firm believer in not using oak in order to give full purity of fruit and expression of terroir.
- 331 Sancerre 2017, Domaine Andre Dezat, Loire Valley 39.50**
100% Sauvignon Blanc. Fresh cut grass and elderflower on the nose with an exquisitely rich palate of gooseberries and citrus, combined with minerally flintiness. A classic which lives up to its' reputation as the great fish dish match.
- 329 Pouilly Fumé 2016, Domaine Cailbourdin, Loire Valley 41.00**
From way up stream on the Loire, on the opposite side of the river from Sancerre is this other iconic wine region. A stalwart of wine lists all over the world, it is Sauvignon Blanc as we used to know. Crisp, fresh with hints of gooseberries and an underlying smokiness this appellation is known for.

Medium to Full Bodied Whites

- 738 **Chenin Blanc, 'The Liberator' 2018, Stellenbosch, South Africa** 21.50
Chenin Blanc is S. Africa's leading white grape, and this particular one is ideal with or without food. Fermented partly in oak, and kept on its' lees it is awesome value with good depth of flavour, and has gorgeous aromas and a long finish.
- 744 **Chardonnay 2017 Gran Reserva , Nostos- Casablanca, Chile** 25.00
If anybody is still dragging their feet when it comes to getting back onto the Chardonnay bandwagon, just point them at this little gem. Winds off the Pacific keep the vineyards cool thereby slowing ripening. The result is a Chardonnay of elegance. Barrel fermented for extra complexity, it is exceptionally pleasing.
- 516 **Rioja Blanco 2016, Lar de Paula** 28.50
Delicious old school white Rioja. Extremely popular style with the fresh fruit complementing the toasty oak beautifully. Full, soft round, it is a wine to enjoy with grilled fish or chowder.
- 238 **Macon Solutre 2017, Domaine Denuziller, Burgundy** 32.00
Elegant and fresh, this wine from Solutre, one of the best villages in the Maconnais, is very pleasing. Fruit driven with no oak, but the lees is stirred giving extra complexity. A real crowd pleaser which is great value.
- 499 **Dom Rafael 2016 Herdade do Mouchao, Alentejo (Portugal)** 32.00
A Unoaked but kept on its' lees for 6 months, this is a gorgeously fresh and citrus style blend, with mouthwatering vibrant aromas of grapefruit, and tropical fruits, just right for combating Atlantic seafood, or as a delicious aperitif.
- 806 **Chardonnay 2014 Foxglove, Central Coast (California)** 36.00
The Varner brothers have produced an absolute beauty with the emphasis on fruit, so there is very little oak influence at all. There are lovely notes of flowers, honeysuckle and hints of white peach. It is elegant and restrained, quite un-Californian, but we love it!
- 726 **Chenin / Viognier 2015 'Saskia', Miles Mossop, W. Cape (S.Africa)** 45.50
A fulsome blend, with aromas of white peaches, and flavours of quince and apricots. Very rich with a lovely balance between fruit and acidity. Absolutely ideal for fish, with or without sauce.
- 362 **Pouilly Loche 'Les Barres' 2016, Clos de Rocs, Burgundy** 49.50
An iconic wine from a small producer based in Loche. The whole of Pouilly Loche AC is only 32 Hectares of which Clos de Rocs own 30%. Very well balanced it has a perfumed, elegant and honeyed nose with great stone fruit and citrus flavours and a pleasing saline minerality.

- 079 Chablis 1er Cru Cote de Lechet 2016, Domaine Defaix, Burgundy 49.50**
From 100% Chardonnay, full bodied yet with elegant fruit backed up by minerals and good acidity known by the French as 'gout de pierre a fusil', or gunflint. Superb length, it really is classy stuff.
- 271 Montagny 1er Cru 'Les Gouresses' 2016, Dom. Jean Marc Pillot 65.00**
Made from vines which are nearly 100 years old, and grown on chalk, there is a real touch of Chablis about this mouth-watering wine. Taut and racy, it opens up beautifully in the glass, reflecting the very precise 2016 vintage.
- 233 Chassagne Montrachet 2016, Dom. Bachey Legros, Burgundy 79.50**
Lovely pale straw in colour, with mouth watering aromas of peaches. Juicy and ripe, with gentle a touch of oak, this is a delicious Burgundy. Whether roast pork, chicken or sea bass this is your ideal combo.
- 279 Puligny Montrachet 2016, Domaine Pernot Belicard, Burgundy 79.50**
Quintessential Burgundy from the world famous appellation. Lovely balanced Chardonnay fruit from the best vineyards. Elegant with a citrus and stone fruit palate and lemon meringue characters. Sensational with fish.
- 594 Meursault Cuvee 'Charles Maxim' 2016, Dom. Latour-Giraud, Burgundy 86.50**
Powerful in every way! Heaps of sensational stone fruit, cashew and toast and honey. Beautifully situated vineyards, low yields and brilliant winemaking all contribute to this very special bottle.
- 240 Puligny Montrachet 2007, Domaine Leflaive, Burgundy 145.00**
Another stupendous wine from Burgundy's leading producers. Gorgeous aromas of acacia flower, white peach, hints of pear together with toast and honey and a touch of vanilla on the palate. This is absolutely delicious and very much drinking at its' peak.

- 848 Riesling 2017, Dr. Loosen, Mosel (Germany) 25.00**
This is what you would expect from top quality Riesling. A delicious wine, with a fresh, zesty nose and a mouthwatering, fruity palate. It is medium dry, and very more-ish!
- 457 Viognier 2017, Ch. Pesquie '974', Rhone Valley 27.50**
The number in the name is the road which takes you to the vineyard....you can't deny the French are romantic!! Nevertheless, the wine speaks for itself. Aromatic and alluring, beautiful apricot and peach flavours abound, and the fruit on the palate lingers on and on.....
- 694 Riesling 2015, Mount Langhi 'Billi Billi', Grampians, Victoria (Aus.) 27.50**
Classic cool climate Riesling flavours leap from the glass, making your mouth water before you even have a sip! Lemon and limes, together with lovely floral overtones. Wonderful with fish and an especially good partner to Asian influenced food. Yum!
- 437 Pinot Bianco 2017, Cantina Bolzano, Alto Adige (Italy) 29.50**
From high up in the foothills of the Tyrol Mountains comes this amazingly crisp, fresh, liquid crystal! With heavenly flavours of green apples, pears and scent of white peach, it is not only a refreshing aperitif but also a superb accompaniment to many salads, and fish dishes.
- 038 Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Staete Landt, Marlborough (NZ) 29.50**
Staete Landt is the name given to what is now New Zealand by Tasman, the Dutch explorer in honour of his country. This is Marlborough Sauvignon at its best. Wonderfully fresh and powerful on the nose this is an intense wine with bags of zesty gooseberry passion fruit and citrus fruit and great concentration of flavour.
- 365 Gewurztraminer Reserve 2016, Joseph Cattin, Alsace 36.50**
A classic Gewurztraminer from Alsace exhibiting lychees and Turkish delight aromas, very intense, unctuous flavours with delicious texture as a result of the old vines. So tasty you will adore it.
- 579 Tenuta di Castellaro Porticello 2017, IGT Sicily 38.00**
This captivating wine is from the island of Lipari just off Sicily has instant appeal leaping from the glass. Made from Carricante and Moscato grown on the volcanic soil, it is intensely flavoured with stunning aromas of apples, honey and white flowers. It's well balanced and long.

- 503 Pinot Gris 2012, Dom. Rolly Gassman, Alsace 46.50**
Truly, truly unctuous! Packed full of spiced citrus, toffee apple, peach and apricot aromas, backed up with a hint of spice on the palate, Off dry, rich and complex, it is God's gift to Spicy cuisine.
- 541 Studio Bianco 2016, Borgo del Tiglio, Friuli Venezia Giulia (Italy) 85.00**
A sumptuous blend of 40% Friulano, 40% Sauvignon and 20% Riesling. Made by one of Italy's best winemakers Nicola Manfredi (how's that for a name!), plying his trade in the slightly less well known region of Friuli in the NE of Italy. Precise and poised, it has gorgeous aromas blackcurrant leaf, white peach, ripe pear and white flowers on the nose and the tropical notes continue on the palate with a long finish.

Rose Wines

- 497 Tempranillo Shiraz Rose 2018, Castillo del Moro - Castillon (Spain) 19.50**
Fresh with good acidity. Tasty flavours of summer berries, it is a pleasure to knock back, morning, noon and night! Top value too.
- 368 Chateau Montaud 2017 - Cotes de Provence 26.50**
Classic Provence rose (even down to the fancy bottle!) With a charming peachy orange colour and with aromas of summer fruits, it is pure elegance in a glass. Despite its' very pale hue it has good weight and goes amazingly well with many foods. Massively popular.
- 361 Chianti Rosato 2017, Rocca di Montegrossi, IGT Toscana 36.50**
This is serious Rose, if there is such a thing....well seriously good anyway! Made from the gentle pressing of Sangiovese grapes from the heart of Chianti. It rests on its' lees for 4 months to enhance the spectacular flavours on the nose and in the mouth. This is a joy and has great fruit and length.
- 346 Sancerre Rose 2017, Domaine Clairnaux - Loire 38.50**
A wonderful alternative for an aperitif or a delightful wine to go with fish. Made using Pinot Noir grapes, it is delicate yet complex. From one of Sancerre's best growers.
